1.4.1- Institution obtains feedback on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution from the following stakeholders

The feedback system at IIP (Indore Institute of Pharmacy) is a crucial component in maintaining and enhancing the quality of education, student experience, and institutional growth. This system is designed to gather insights and perspectives from various stakeholders, including students, parents, and alumni, in an efficient and systematic manner.

The feedback system is hosted on a user-friendly online platform that can be accessed by students, parents, and alumni from any location, making it convenient for all stakeholders. This eliminates the need for physical forms or manual processes, ensuring that feedback is gathered in real-time. The institute shares the feedback link and the stakeholders fills and submit the feedback form and we generate the report and plan for further actions to be taken on the parameters which results in less than 80%.

- 1. Course End Survey Feedback: The feedback form for students includes questions about the quality of teaching, course content, facilities, campus environment, and overall satisfaction. Students are encouraged to evaluate faculty members, course structure, infrastructure, and their overall learning experience at the end of each semester (last day of their RGPV end semester exam).
- Parent Feedback: Parents are asked to assess their child's academic progress, communication between
 the institute and the family, and the overall educational experience. This feedback helps the institution
 understand parental concerns and expectations. The link is shared and communicated to parents about
 the importance of their feedback. After the submission, report is generated.
- Program Feedback: To cater to the unique needs of each academic program, the feedback system
 offers program-specific forms for B.Pharm, D.Pharm, and M.Pharm students. This helps ensure that
 the feedback is relevant to the course content, teaching methodologies, and overall learning experience
 of each program.
- 4. Alumni Feedback: Alumni feedback focuses on how well the institution prepared them for their careers, the relevance of the curriculum in the industry, and their post-graduation experiences. Alumni are also asked to provide suggestions for improving the curriculum based on their professional journey.
