RULES FOR ADMISSION TO ENGINEERING/PHARMACY DIPLOMA HOLDERS/SCIENCE GRADUATES (with Mathematics in 10+2 Exam) THROUGH LATERAL ENTRY IN SECOND YEAR (THIRD SEMESTER) OF UNDER GRADUATE COURSES IN

ENGINEERING/TECHNOLOGY APPROVED BY AICTE AND PHARMACY APPROVED BY PCI IN NON AIDED PRIVATE ENGINEERING/PHARMACY INSTITUTIONS IN MP AS PER THE RULES PUBLISHED IN MADHYA PRADESH GAZETTE DATED 1ST DECEMBER, 2007 AND AS AMMENDED AND UNDER THE PROVISIONS MADE IN MADHYA PRADESH NIJI VYAVASAYIK SHIKSHAN SANSTHA (PRAVESH KA VINIYAMAN AVAM SHULK KA NIRDHARAN) ADHINIYAM, 2007 NO. 21.

2.1 Short Title and Commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called admission rules, 2008.

2.2 Definitions:

In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) "Act" means the Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavsayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk Ka Nirdharan) Adhiniyam, 2007 (No. 21 of 2007);
- (b) "Admissions and Fee Regulatory Committee" means the Committee constituted by the State Government for the supervision and guidance of admission process and for the fixation of fee to be charged from candidates seeking admission in a professional educational institution;
- (c) "AICTE" means All India Council for Technical Education a statutory body established by All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987;
- (d) "Common Entrance Test" means the entrance tests for admission in Various technical and professional courses conducted by an agency duly authorized by the State Government for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "Competent Authority" means any authority as authorized by the State Government in this behalf;
- (f) "CTE" means Commissioner of Technical Education Madhya Pradesh;
- (g) "Fee" means all fees including tuition fee and development charges;
- (h) "Non resident Indian" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in clause (e) of Section 115c of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (43 of 1961).
- (i) "Principal" means Head of institution;





- (j) "Private Unaided Professional Institution" means the professional institutions which does not receive recurring aid or grant-in-aid from any State or Central Government;
- (k) "Professional Institution" means a college or institute including a private university established or incorporated by an Act of the State Legislature or Constituent unit of a deemed university defined under section 3 of University Grant Commission Act, 1956;
- (l) "Qualifying Examination" means the examination of the minimum qualification, passing of which entitles one to seek admission into the relevant Professional Courses as prescribed in these rules;
- (m) "Single Window System" means a system by which available seats in all the institutions are offered through Common Centralized Counselling or Decentralize Online Conselling to qualified candidates in order of merit in the Common Entrance Test;
- (n) The words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

OTHER ABBREVIATIONS USED IN THIS RULE BOOK ARE:-

- (I) RGPV means Rajeev Gandhi Prodhoyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya, Bhopal; (II) 'M.P.' means State of Madhya Pradesh as formed on 01-11-2000.
- (III) 'PCI' means Pharmacy Council of India

2.3 Applicability –

These rules shall be applicable to unaided private Technical institutions which are conducting Under Graduate courses/ programmes in Engineering, Technology duly sanctioned and approved by AICTE and Pharmacy duly sanctioned and approved by PCI from time to time.

2.4 Admission rules -

Admission shall be as under–

2.4.1 Availability of seats (Extent of Lateral Entry)–

- (a) Maximum 10 percent seats over and above the sanctioned intake (supernumerary) of previous academic year shall be available for admission through lateral entry scheme in second year Engineering degree (B.E./B.Tech) course and Maximum 10 percent seats over and above the sanctioned intake (supernumerary) of previous academic year shall be available for admission through lateral entry scheme in second year Pharmacy degree (BPharmacy) course.

The details of Institutions, branches and seats shall be available on the website of Counselling Authority i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>.



- (b) The unfilled / vacant seats of previous academic year of first year will also be available for admission in lateral entry scheme.

2.4.2 Allocation/ Reservation of seats-

In every institution **16%, 20% and 14%** of available seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to **SC, ST and OBC** categories (excluding creamy layer) respectively as notified by the state government in this regard for M.P. domicile only.

2.4.2.1 Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Category of Madhya Pradesh:

A candidate claiming to be either of SC or ST category of MP shall have to produce a certificate from the competent authority in **Proforma-1**(Annexer-1) as given in this rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD order No. F.7-2/96 भोपाल, दिनांक 01-08-1996 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P.

2.4.2.2 OBC category of Madhya Pradesh

A candidate claiming reservation under OBC (excluding creamy layer) category shall have to produce a certificate at the time of verification of documents issued by the competent authority in **Proforma-2**(Annexer-1) as given in the rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD order No. F/72/96 आ.प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 12.03.1997 and order no. ,F-7-2/96 आ.प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 06.07.2000 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P. regarding creamy layer. The candidate should also bring an income certificate at the time of verification of documents regarding his/her family's income from the Competent Authority or self declaration regarding income as prescribed by GAD, Government of M.P. by his circular no. सी-3-7-2013-3-एक, दिनांक 25/09/2014

(Proforma-10) (Annexer-6) and stating that his/her parents do not come


under creamy layer if OBC certificate is issued before 30th April, 2020. **2.5 Eligibility for admission-**

- 2.5.1 As per the guidelines prescribed by AICTE and State Government.
2.5.2 The candidates should be an Indian national.
2.5.3 Educational qualifications:

(i) A degree programme in Engineering at the second year (Third semester) level

A Candidate must have passed a regular Three years / Two years (Through Lateral Entry) engineering diploma programme examination in ANY branch of Engineering/Technology from an Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC or from a foreign University recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) or institute recognized by the concerned University as equivalent thereto, with minimum marks of 45 percent;

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

OR

Candidate must have passed B.Sc. Degree examination from a university recognized by the university grants commission with minimum 45 percent marks and have passed 10+2 examination with mathematics as a subject.

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

(ii) A Degree Programme in Pharmacy at the second year (Third Semester) level

Passed Diploma Pharmacy course from an institutions approved by the PCI u/s 12 of Pharmacy Act. 1948.

2.5.4 Weightage of 10 percent of the marks in the qualifying exam shall be given to those candidates who have been awarded **Gold Medal** in the National level Sports Competition. To obtained the above benefits candidates shall have to produce the certificate from Director, Department of Sports & Youth Welfare, and Government of Madhya Pradesh in specified **Proforma-9** (Annexure-5).

2.5.5 Domicile Requirements:

No candidate belonging to SC, ST & OBC (Excluding Creamy Layer) category shall be selected for admission against the seats reserved for them unless

मध्य प्रदेश निजी व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था (प्रवेश का विनियमन एवं शुल्क का निर्धारण) अधिनियम-2007 (क्रमांक 21 सन् 2007) के अंतर्गत दिनांक 15 अप्रैल 2008 को मध्यप्रदेश राजपत्र में प्रकाशित नियमों के अनुसार सहायता न पाने वाली निजी व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्थाओं में प्रवेश की पात्रता, प्रवेश की रीति तथा स्थानों के आरक्षण के संबंध में बी.फार्मा. एवं डी.फार्मा. पाठ्यक्रमों के प्रथम वर्ष में प्रवेश के नियम:-

2.1 संक्षिप्त नाम तथा प्रारंभ :-

- (1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम प्रवेश नियम, 2008 है।
- (2) ये मध्यप्रदेश राजपत्र में प्रकाशित 15 अप्रैल, 2008 से प्रवृत्त हैं एवं संशोधन मध्यप्रदेश राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तिथि से लागू हैं।

2.2 परिभाषाएं :-

इन नियमों में, जब तक संदर्भ से अन्यथा अपेक्षित न हो,

- (क) "अधिनियम" से अभिप्रेत है, मध्यप्रदेश निजी व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था (प्रवेश का विनियमन एवं शुल्क का निर्धारण) अधिनियम, 2007 (क्रमांक 21 सन् 2007);
- (ख) "समुचित प्राधिकारी" से अभिप्रेत है, अधिनियम की धारा 3 के खण्ड (क) में यथा परिभाषित प्राधिकारी;
- (ग) "प्रवेश तथा फीस विनियामक समिति" से अभिप्रेत है, व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था में प्रवेश प्रक्रिया के पर्यवेक्षण तथा मार्गदर्शन के लिए तथा प्रवेश के इच्छुक अभ्यर्थियों से प्रभारित की जाने वाली फीस के निर्धारण के लिए इस अधिनियम के अधीन राज्य सरकार द्वारा गठित समिति;
- (घ) "PCI" से अभिप्रेत है फार्मसी काउंसिल ऑफ इंडिया, नई दिल्ली;
- (ङ) "उपाबंध" से अभिप्रेत है इन नियमों से संलग्न उपाबंध;
- (च) "सक्षम प्राधिकारी" से अभिप्रेत है, राज्य सरकार द्वारा इस निमित्त प्राधिकृत कोई अधिकारी;
- (च-1) "पाठ्यक्रम" से अभिप्रेत हैं कोई पाठ्यक्रम जिसकी नाम पदवृत्ति समुचित प्राधिकारी द्वारा अनुमोदित की जा चुकी हैं तथा जिसके लिये किसी मान्यता प्राप्त विश्वविद्यालय या बोर्ड या संस्था द्वारा अलग से

- (ख) "फीस" से अभिप्रेत हैं, शिक्षण फीस सहित समस्त फीस तथा विकास प्रभार;
- (ज) "अनिवासी भारतीय" का वही अर्थ होगा जो आयकर अधिनियम, 1961 (1961 का 43) की धारा 115-ग के खण्ड (ड.) में उसके लिए दिया गया है;
- (झ) "प्राचार्य" से अभिप्रेत हैं, संस्था का प्रमुख;
- (ञ) "सहायता न पाने वाली निजी व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था" से अभिप्रेत हैं, कोई व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था, जो किसी राज्य या केन्द्रीय सरकार से आवर्ती वित्तीय सहायता या सहायता अनुदान प्राप्त नहीं कर रही हो तथा जो केन्द्रीय सरकार, राज्य सरकार या किसी सार्वजनिक निकाय द्वारा स्थापित या पोषित नहीं हैं;
- (ट) "व्यावसायिक शिक्षण संस्था" से अभिप्रेत हैं, व्यावसायिक शिक्षा प्रदान कर रहा कोई महाविद्यालय या कोई स्कूल या कोई संस्थान, चाहे वह किसी भी नाम से ज्ञात हो, जो राज्य के किसी विश्वविद्यालय से संबद्ध हो जिसमें राज्य विधान मंडल के अधिनियम द्वारा स्थापित या निगमित कोई निजी विश्वविद्यालय या विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग अधिनियम, 1956 (1956 का सं.3) की धारा 3 के अधीन विश्वविद्यालय होना समझी गई कोई संघटक इकाई सम्मिलित है, और जो व्यावसायिक शिक्षण को विनियमित करने वाले किसी सक्षम कानूनी निकाय द्वारा अनुमोदित या मान्यता प्राप्त हो;
- (ठ) "अर्हकारी परीक्षा" से अभिप्रेत हैं, उस न्यूनतम अर्हता की परीक्षा जिसको उत्तीर्ण करने पर कोई अभ्यर्थी इन नियमों में यथाविहित सुसंगत व्यावसायिक पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रवेश चाहने हेतु हकदार होता है;
- (ड) "एकल खिड़की प्रणाली" से अभिप्रेत हैं, ऐसी प्रणाली, जिसके द्वारा सभी संस्थाओं में उपलब्ध स्थान, सामान्य केन्द्रीकृत परामर्श (काउन्सलिंग) या विकेन्द्रीकृत ऑनलाईन परामर्श (काउन्सलिंग) के माध्यम से सामान्य प्रवेश परीक्षा के गुणागुण के क्रम में अर्ह अभ्यर्थियों को प्रस्थापित किए जाते हैं;
- (ढ) उन शब्दों तथा अभिव्यक्तियों का, जो इन नियमों में प्रयुक्त की गई हैं, किन्तु परिभाषित नहीं की गई हैं, वही अर्थ होगा जो अधिनियम में उनके लिए दिया गया है।

Reservation for Economical weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh

As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh GAD letter no F-7-11/2019/1, Bhopal, dated 02nd July 2019, and as per Pharmacy Council of India, Pharmacy set 1948 w/s 12, ten percent seats of approved intake will be available for economically weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh.

Tuition fee waiver scheme seats mean as per Pharmacy Council of India, Pharmacy act 1948 as 12, for the approved intake in the institution, 5% seats are available supernumerary. These seats will be available for Madhya Pradesh domicile candidates whose family annual income from all sources should not be more than 8 lac (Rupees eight lac only)

Allocation/reservation of seats-

In every institution, **16%, 20%, and 14%** seats of sanctioned intake shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to **SC, ST, and OBC** (excluding creamy layer) categories respectively as notified by the state government in this regard.



1. Candidates securing equal marks in qualifying exam then Preference will be given in merit to those candidates who secure more marks in

Mathematics/Biology, if marks are equal in Mathematics/Biology then Preference in merit will be given to those candidate who secure more marks in Physics, if marks are equal in Physics then Preference in merit will be given to those candidate who secure more marks in Chemistry, if marks are equal in Chemistry then Preference in merit will be given to those candidate who is Older in age, if age are same then candidates merit will be decided on the basis of English alphabetical order of candidates name. For D. Pharm candidates securing equal marks in qualifying exam then Preference will be given in merit to those candidates who is Older in age, if age are same then candidates merit will be decided on the basis of English alphabetical order of candidates name.

1. All such candidate who has passed qualifying examination with grace marks are also eligible for admission
2. All such candidates whose qualifying examination marksheet are based on grading system will have to produce conversion of grade to marks as per the conversion formula mentioned in their marksheet.

1.5 Procedure of Admission

Online Off-campus Admission Procedure :

The competent authority declared by the State Government for online off campus counseling, shall finalize the detailed programme and shall make it available on its website declaring its procedure, process of admission and different cut off dates. Procedure of Online Off Campus Counselling will be followed as per the regulation published in MP Government Gazette dated 31st July, 2009 (As amended) for Online Off Campus Counselling.

1.6 Common Merit List:

Admission shall be done by the Counselling Authority through Counselling on the basis of marks obtained by candidates in the qualifying examination.

1.6.1 General Information of admission

1.8.1.1 Admission shall be done through Counselling on the basis of marks obtained by candidates in the qualifying examination. The programme of Counselling shall be published in various news papers and shall also be available on website of competent authority/Director Technical Education, M.P. Bhopal i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>. No separate call letters shall be sent to the candidates.

1.8.1.2 Original Documents

During the Counselling process the original documents presented by the candidates shall be verified with originals and original documents will be returned back to the candidates. However candidates need not to submit such original documents in the admitted institutions.

1.8.1.3 Transfer of institution in first year of the course shall not be permitted.
