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## Introduction

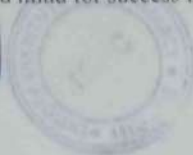

### Report

A workshop on **Computer-Aided Drug Design (CADD)** using **DruLiTo** software was conducted to provide participants with hands-on experience and theoretical knowledge about the process of virtual drug discovery and development. The event aimed to introduce the fundamentals of CADD and demonstrate the capabilities of DruLiTo, a tool specifically designed for molecular filtering based on Lipinski's Rule of Five and other drug-likeness criteria.

#### Objectives

The key objectives of the workshop were:

2. To familiarize attendees with DruLiTo software for evaluating the drug-likeness of molecules.
3. To enable participants to perform molecular screening and filter potential drug candidates.

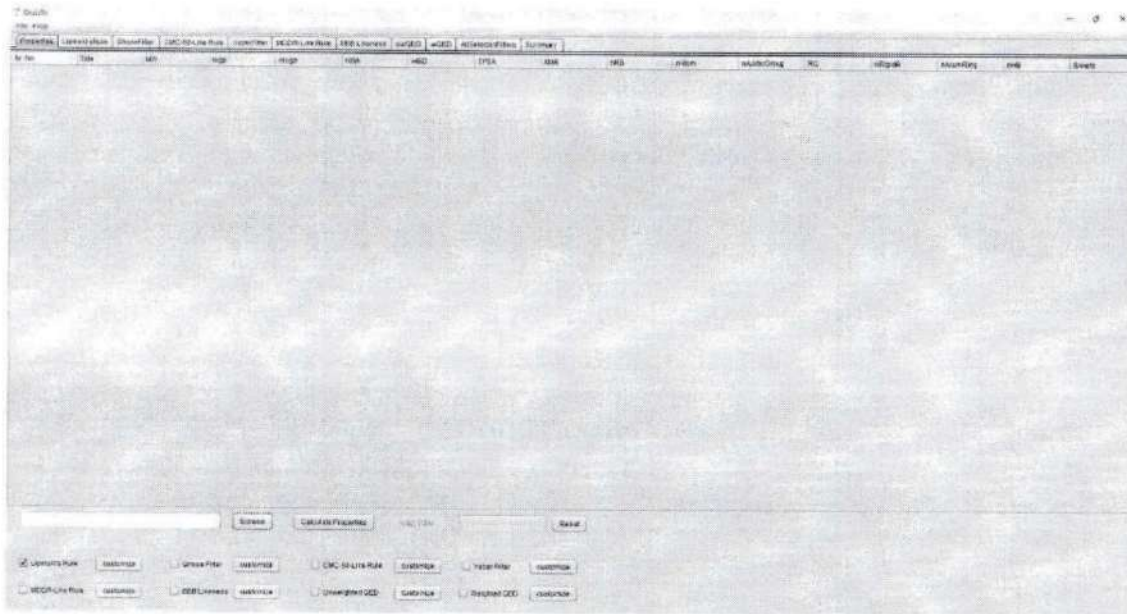

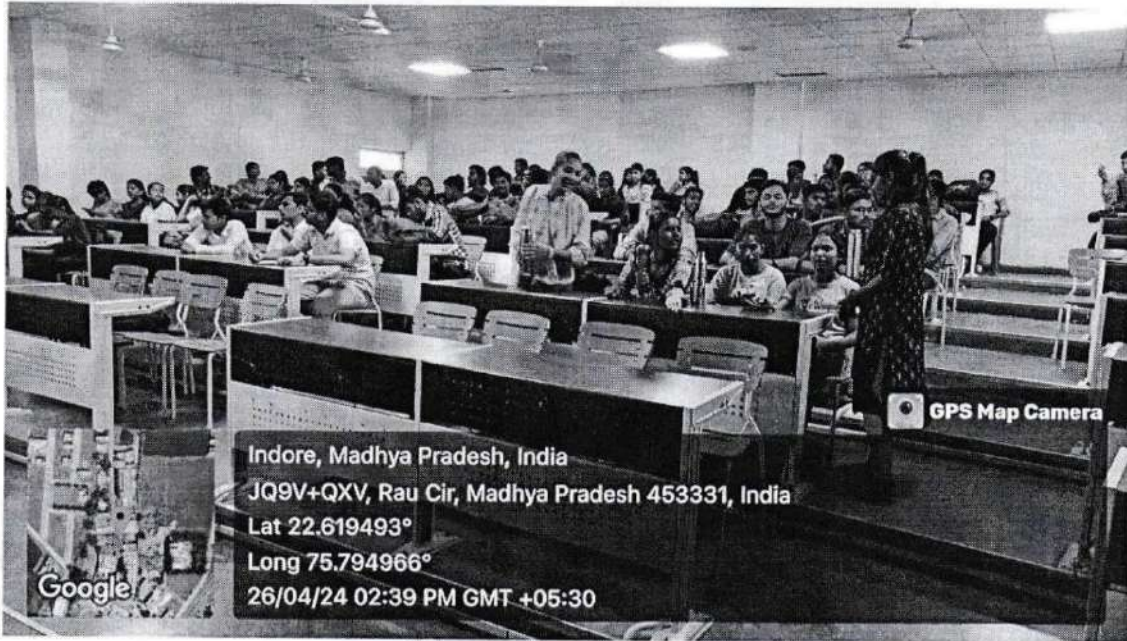

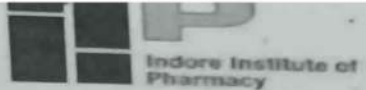
