7.1.5 Green campus initiatives include;

Green Wave Club: Green Waves Club was introduced in the year 2018. Motive of Green Wave Club is to provide an opportunity to students to do something positive for the community and the environment by connecting with nature.

The goals of Green Waves Club are as follows:

- Conserving Biodiversity by Planting Trees
- By water harvesting in our campus & water management in our day to day usage
- Promoting Agroforestry
- By Cultivating Organic Vegetables & Crops
- Say “Big No” to use of Plastic bags, bottles, Cans etc.

Activity “Tree Plantation” is held every year at the time of **Induction Programme** of newly coming students by teaming with Director General Shri Arun S Bhatnagar Sir, our Principal, Teachers and Staff Members to plant trees on Institute Premises, plantation is done by **some of the guest** who visits our institute and the plantation activity is also done every year in nearby **villages** to promote the greenery. We at our institute believe that these activities under Green Wave Club may provide multiple benefits by improving environmental conditions and providing multi-disciplinary learning for students of all ages. It teaches them about plants and shows them how their efforts make an impact that they and their communities can revisit for years.

(A) Restricted entry of automobiles:


To prevent huge vehicles from accidentally entering the campus, our institution established a **restriction on automobile admission**. Our college has a group of buses to transport many students from different places within the city and in suburban areas. This initiative helps in **reducing pollution and consumption of petrol**.

Our institution had provides restriction for entry of automobiles. Our institution has a big gate for vehicles, which is to be opened only during entry of vehicles and has a small entry for pedestrians. With this type of facility there is no chance of accidental entry of large vehicles in the campus with these Pedestrian friendly pathways.

(B) Bicycles/Battery powered vehicles for Pollution-Free Environment

As a step towards complete pollution-free environment in campus, bicycles are provided for use by boy’s & girl’s Hostel students to commute from Main gate to Hostel and to avoid two-wheelers movement inside campus.

Bicycles are also provided for faculties members and non-teaching staff.

The provisions for parking the cycles are provided both in the Main gate and also in the front gates for the benefit of the students.

(C) Pedestrian Friendly Pathways:

Roads inside campus are strictly prohibited for use of two-wheelers and four-wheelers except utility vehicles. The roads are fully used only for pedestrian purpose.

All vehicles should be **parked in the respective places** allotted by the security and they are not allowed to enter beyond the barricade placed at the entrance of the campus, unless if there is an emergency or special case.

(D) Ban on Use of Plastic:

A policy is in place to convert our campus into a **Plastic-free campus**. Within the context of our Green campus policy we commit to ban the use of plastics, to reduce the environmental impact of waste plastics. Usages of plastics are avoided in the canteen by serving the food in the steel plates.

(E) Landscaping with Trees and Plants

The campus had **approx.1700 trees in previous year** and **now in this year**, institute has planted **approx. 100 trees** in the campus. Now the total number of trees in campus is **approx. 1800 Nos.**

Organic Vegetable garden is formed in open land space in Girl's Hostel area. The entire campus is dotted with trees, plants and lawns which are kept well maintained.

The 50 acres of lush green sprawling campus has well maintained greenery and biodiversity. Varieties of ornamental plants are grown with scientific methods of Horticulture. **Organic farming** is being practiced and crops & vegetables without chemicals are produced to supply in canteen.

- With 224 varieties of medicinal plants alongwith **17 Red listed Indigenous plants** Hence we have **biggest Dhanwantary Herbal garden in Madhya Pradesh.**
- We are also working on conservation of plants which are at the stage of Extinction from the forest of Madhya Pradesh.
- More than 1800 plants have been planted in the campus.
- The college maintains beautiful garden of decorative & flowering plants.
- Every year Plantation Drives are organized for newly admitted students.
- **Kalpriksha vatika** contains trees for biological diversity with Spiritual importance. The trees here are the shelter and food sources of various birds and squirrels.
- **Pragyan vatika** is shelter of Gir species of Cow and it is specially developed to promote the organic farming in our campus by using Cow urine and their Bio waste to produce bioorganic manure.
- The **Khus plantation** resides near channel helps in prevention of soils erosion during rainy season.
- The entire plantaion helps in lowering the temp. of campus during summer season up to 1-2°C.

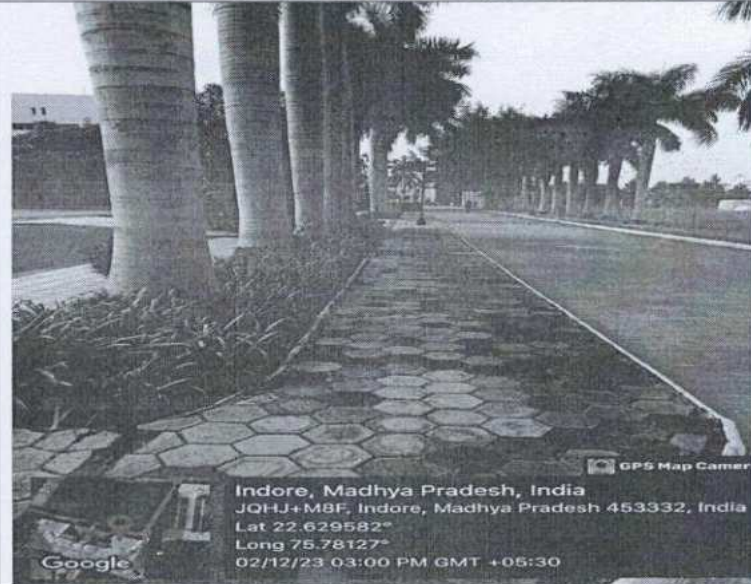

- The college encourages the employees and students to frequently use public transport, bicycles, etc. to limit the emissions.



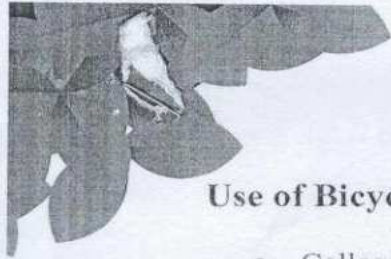
