7.1.7 The Institution has Divyangjan-friendly, barrier free environment;

Indore Institute of Pharmacy provides barrier-free environment where people with disabilities can move about safely and freely and use the facilities within the built environment. The environment supports the independent functioning of individuals so that they can participate without assistance in everyday activities within the campus. RAMP, Ramp-Rails, Stair Case Railings, Signage including display boards and signposts are built for the differently abled person.

1. Built environment with ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms.

a. Ramp-Rails

An inclined plane, are built in addition to staircases in the entrance of college buildings. The ramps are carefully designed as per specifications to be used by the differently abled people.

b. Stair Case Railings:

The partially disabled person who can use stair case can take support of railings for reaching the different floors.

2. Divyangjan -friendly washrooms

There are differently abled friendly restrooms in all the floors. These accessible restrooms carry the fixtures and fittings that are comfortable and convenient to the differently abled people. Non slip floor, sliding door provides easy access to the differently abled people.

3. Signage including tactile path, display boards and signposts

Sign boards ensure visually impaired persons are able to familiarize with the road and path. Tactile sign on handrails at the ends of a staircase, guide the visually impaired.


4. Assistive technology and facilities for persons with disabilities (Divyangjan)

4. Assistive technology and facilities for persons with screen-reading software.

Screen Reading (NVDA) Software:

The institution have free open source NVDA (Non Visual Desktop Access) portable screen reader software, which is installed in the computer labs for the blind students, who deserve to access computers. NVDA allows blind and vision impaired people to access and interact with the Windows operating system and many third party applications. The institution is not having any such vision impaired students to use the software.

Human assistance is also provided to persons with disabilities in terms of a person available on welcome desk at entrance point of the institute.

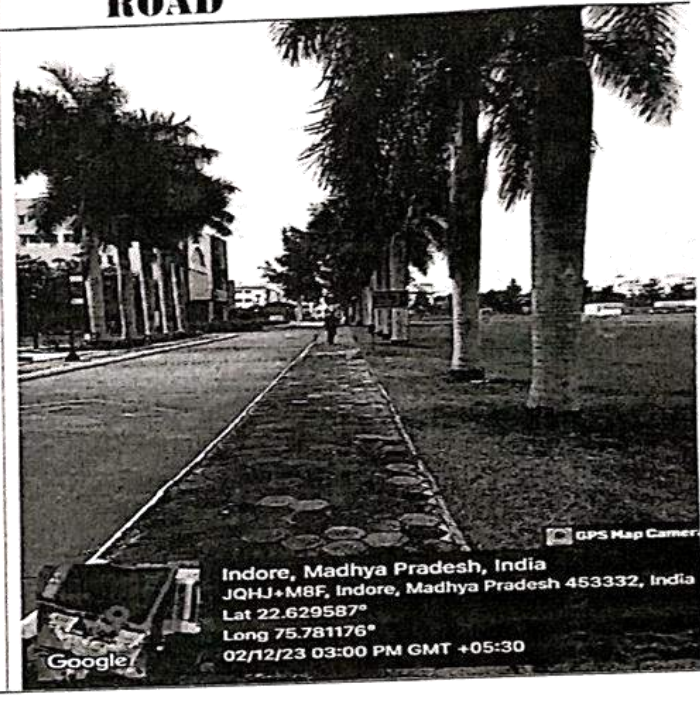
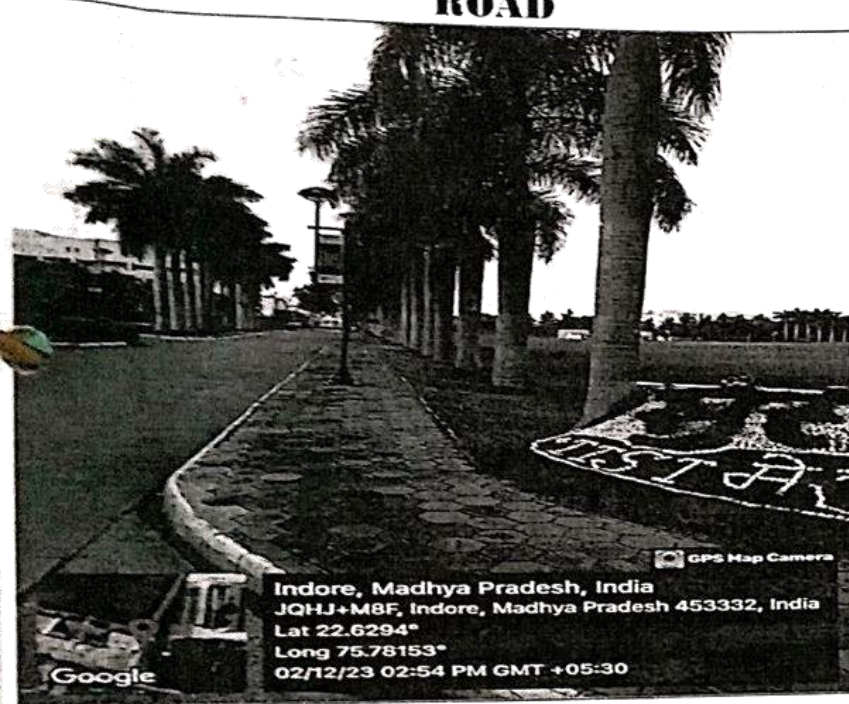
